



UK Bungee at Magna Information for Schools and Colleges



In partnership with Magna, the UK Bungee club offers a range of indoor, adventure activities suitable for KS2 through to Post-16. The two waiver forms enclosed with this pack must be completed for students and pupils under the age of 16 who wish to Abseil, Powerfan or Bungee Jump. For the Zip Wire no waiver forms are required by UK Bungee.

Zip Wire

Step off the crane platform and experience the forces and motion as you slide down the Zip Wire. With a minimum level of instruction required, the Zip Wire is a perfect way of including pupils from all backgrounds. Over 70ft up in the air, the Zip Wire stretches out 250ft down the length of Magna. You'll find yourself flying over old melting pots from a bygone era, while friends watch you the whole way from the walkway.



Abseil

Abseiling is an exciting activity requiring the participants to control their own descent down a rope to the ground. Climb the steps 150ft up into the Face of Steel to arrive at our purpose built abseil platform, where our qualified instructor will explain the principles involved, build your confidence, and set you on your way. This is a free abseil meaning that you abseil into free air and not down the side of a wall.



Powerfan

The Powerfan is unique to Magna, being the only one in the world from this height. The Powerfan is a machine engineered to provide a taste of freefall; the device safely controls the user's descent, dissipating kinetic energy by means of a fan. Fully kitted out in a safety harness and attached to the Powerfan's cable, you step off the platform high up in the Face of Steel and make an initial, rapid descent towards the floor before the fan system kicks in and ensures a soft landing.



Bungee Jump

The 'Abyss @ Magna' is the world's highest indoor Bungee Jump and the only permanent bungee jumping facility in the UK. Climb the 143 steps through the semi-darkness to stand 150ft above the floor. Safely harnessed and with the bungee cord secured, jump off the platform and let gravity takeover. Transferring potential to kinetic energy and back again, bungee past giant relics of the old steelworks before being gently lowered to a soft landing on the ground.

(i) **do hereby acknowledge that:**

- (a) bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding are dangerous activities and that it involves the risk to me/my child

Full Name (please print) of death or bodily injury;

- (b) of my own free will and desire, I wish to participate/I am prepared to allow my said child to participate, in the activity of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding and to do so at my own risk, and I accept full responsibility of any injury resulting there from, whether giving rise to a cause of action falling within the scope of paragraph (ii) (a) or (b) hereof or not, whether suffered by myself or my said child and whether fatal or otherwise. Without in any way limiting or detracting from the scope of the foregoing, injuries includes damage of any kind to the back, neck spinal column, brain, blood vessels (including the blood vessels serving or related to the eyes), eyes, nerves (including ocular nerves), central nervous system, cardio vascular system and also includes shock **AND** includes the event of a miscarriage suffered by any female as a result of participating in bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding.

(ii) **agree to indemnify and otherwise hold harmless**, the Operator, its officers, its committee, and person or business or company employed or authorised by the club for the carrying on of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding or any ancillary activity, from all and any caused of action, **whether** for damages, compensation or any other orders whatsoever, **whether** at common law, in equity, under statute or otherwise howsoever caused by my negligence or failure to follow proper instructions;

- (a) in and about the conduct of the activity of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding including any activity or any procedure preceding or following the execution of a jump whether or not those activities or procedures are part of the preparation for or the recovery from a jump;

- (b) in and about the conduct of activities associated with or supplementary to or ancillary to the activity of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding whether such activities are carried on by the Operator or some other person and whether such activities involve the offering for sale to the public or any section or group of the public or to any individual whatsoever of meals and/or refreshments and/or entertainment and/or activity of any kind whatsoever including the offering for sale of any goods or services whatsoever.

AND WHETHER such causes of action would be available to me in my own right or be available to be brought by me on behalf of or for the benefit of another or be available to be brought by me on behalf of myself and of another.

(iii) **do hereby acknowledge and warrant that:**

- (a) I am not aware of any present or past medical and/or physical condition which might endanger myself/my child or others whilst participating in the activity of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding. In particular, but without anyway cutting down the scope of the preceding sentence:

- (i) I am not/my said child is not pregnant;
- (ii) I am not/my said child is not suffering from any ailment or defective condition of the heart, the lungs, the central nervous system, the vascular system, the muscles of the neck, back, legs or those connected with the eyes or of the eyes;

- (b) no medical practitioner has advised me/my said child against participating in bungee jumping, catapulting and cage riding.

(iv) Nothing in this Waiver shall exclude the liability of the Operator for the death of or personal injury to any person caused by its negligence of that of its officers, committee, employees or agents.

In consideration of the Operator allowing me/my child to proceed with bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding I hereby release the Operator and any person, firm or corporation engaged by it from all and any rights or entitlement that I/my child may otherwise have to any permanent or transient, moving or still, video or audio record leading up to my bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding through to the time after the completion of my bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding being used for any purpose that the Operator may consider appropriate.

I am fully aware that the risks involved with regards to non-standard jumps include:

- (a) a greater risk of entanglement with the bungee cord, and/or contact on collision with the bungee cord end attachments (i.e. hardware components), and/or other equipment.
 - (b) A higher risk of procedure/system, and/or equipment failure.
 - (c) A greater risk of aggravating any present or past medical and/or physical condition.
 - (d) A higher risk or operator error.
- With regards to non-standard rides in the man-cage:
- (a) A more uncomfortable ride in the man-cage.
 - (b) A higher risk of falling out of the man-cage.

(iii) do hereby acknowledge that:

this non-standard waiver form is to be used in addition to, and in conjunction with, the initial standard waiver form which I have already read and signed. The initial standard waiver form acknowledges, amongst other things, that I:
